Pictographics

Shallow, two-dimensional graphics span the wealth of the carver's observation and imagination. Everything from flora to fauna, earth to sky, from the natural world to the man-made world, is documented in the pictorial style.

PLATE # 30

Pictographic images, usually carved in two-dimensional low relief, were suited to the flat surfaces of the mocotaugan handles. This 20th century example is engraved with a moose, a cod, an eight-point star and a shamrock heart, and is initialed "TL."
